



Registering Your Computer(s) on the UD Network


- Change your password

Return to the Main Network Page

1. Go to www.udel.edu/network (Note: your device must be connected to the UDEL network in Arsht hall.)
2. Log in at the prompts [1] Note: You need to have a registered UDEL login account. For information, please visit the main office in Arsht Hall.
3. When you get to the Network Page [2], click on the link: "Register a computer for internet access."
4. You will be given an opportunity to register your device, which will be automatically sensed via your device MAC address (Media Access Control = a unique hardware address). Give your device a personal identification, I just called my two devices *MacBook* and *iPhone*.
5. The "Registered Computers" page [3] will show your registered devices. You can modify or delete these from this page.
6. Log out of your account.
