The **Checkerboard** indicates areas of transparency, ie; no pixels present and you see pixels in layer(s) below.

This is a **Hidden Layer** indicated by the missing eye

This is a special "**Stamp Visible**" Layer.
SHIFT-OPT-CMD-E (Mac)

The "florin" (great trivia) means that this layer has a **Layer Style** applied to it. Double-click it to modify.

Layers above the Background Layer can be moved by dragging them up/down

Background Layer is partially locked. It can't be moved or transformed unless it's converted to a "Regular Image" layer.

Remember that Layer commands are accessible via the LAYER menu and/or the "More" fly-out menu at the top-right of the Layers Palette.
